Entry Information

The SavorNW wine competition is open to all types of wines made or produced in Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Alaska and British Columbia. A producer can enter as many wines as desired, as long as each product entered is either currently available for retail sale or scheduled for release in commercial quantities to the public during 2022. All wines must be vinified and bottled by a licensed and bonded winery and must be produced from 100 percent grapes grown within Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Alaska or British Columbia. Wines must be entered into appropriate categories as defined by state/provincial standards for varietal labeling.

The entry fee is \$65 per wine and may be paid online with PayPal via our website or by check. If paid online, please include the email used on your PayPal account on your entry form. Make checks payable to Explorer Media Group, Inc.

Submission of Entries

Submit three (3) 750ml bottles for all dry table wine entries and sparkling wine entries or four (4) bottles of 375ml or 500ml dessert-style wines with your completed entry form(s).
